Member Information Protection Officers are people trained to be the first point of contact within sporting organisations for any person considering making a complaint under the Member Protection Policy.

An MPIO provides confidential, impartial and timely information and support. They act as a sounding board and provide information about the local complaint resolution options available to address the individual's concerns.

What DO Member Protection Information Officers do?

- Listen and maintain confidentiality
- Act as an impartial support person
- Provide information about discrimination, harassment and child abuse
- Provide information about the Member Protection Policy and the options available to resolve the complaint
- Provide information about access to relevant laws and the rights of the complainant
- Discuss possible strategies the individual can use to deal directly with the issue
- Provide contact details for further assistance or support
